Required Paint Colors

- Titanium White
- Cadmium Red Light
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Alizarin Crimson
- French Ultramarine Blue
- Phthalo Blue
- Phthalo Green
- Sap Green
- Any other colors you already have and like!!!

Brushes

- Brushes specific to OIL painting in various sizes & styles. Hog bristle, sable or taklon work best. I suggest an assortment of Round, Flat, Bright, Filbert, Fan & Rigger brushes.



Palette

- Large Palette Paper. I suggest 9x12 or 12x16
- OR Covered Palette with glass insert (This is the best way to save your paints)

Canvas

- Pad of canvas paper
- Canvas in various sizes – You will only need to bring 1 to start off with. I recommend you start with canvas no bigger that 16x20.”

Miscellaneous

- Small Sketchbook
- Palette Knife, used to mix paints and paint with
- Paper Towels & Rags
- Gasol
- 2 Jars with lids to hold solvent

Medium

- Liquin
- Linseed oil
